



A message from your Calgary Police Service Community Resource Unit:

This area has had an increase in residential break-ins, vehicle prowlings, and thefts from insecure garages.

In order to proactively prevent these crimes, we would like to pass on the following tips:

1. Don't leave your garage door up or unlocked at any time, and ensure all home doors and windows are secure.
2. Make sure all valuables are either locked, out of sight or removed from your vehicle, including the electronic garage door opener.
3. Ensure your vehicle is locked and secure when you leave it, even for a short period of time.
4. Do not leave your vehicle running unattended with the keys in the ignition.
5. Do not leave spare keys in your vehicle, even if they are out of sight.
6. Consider a home alarm system, security cameras and security lighting.
7. Get to know your neighbours and work together to be the eyes and ears of the community.
8. Report suspicious activity to police. Call 911 to report a crime in progress.
